We are a purebred cow/calf operation consisting of 150 head of Simmental, SimAngus and Herefords. Pasture and row crops consist of about 500 acres. We put up annually small squares of hay and straw, as well as large bales of alfalfa and straw plus corn silage. We wean our heifer calves and a few bull calves June 1st to prepare the top 25 to 30 to sell in our production sale the 2nd Sunday in September. The intern is solely responsible for halter break and working with the 25 to 30 heifer calves as well as working with existing show heifers. The intern also helps with heat detection, checking summer pastures, assist in crop production, driving & moving farm equipment, baling about 2500 small squares of hay & straw and other daily duties of the operation. Internship would start mid-May and end about the 10th of August. Attendance to cattle shows would be limited. This is a fairly labor intensive and physical internship. Intern must also enjoy working with young children and teenagers.
